

1. First and Emergency Aid Program

1.1. History

The First and Emergency Aid Program became operational with the intake of students in the 2021-2022 academic year.

1.2. Grade Earned

Students who successfully complete this program receive the "First and Emergency Aid Technician (Paramedic) Associate Degree Diploma" at the end of the 4th semester.

1.3. Acceptance Conditions

Students are admitted to the program according to the Basic Proficiency Test (TYT) score made by OSYM within the framework of the academic and legal regulations of the university. A student who has started his education in an equivalent program in the country or abroad can apply for horizontal transfer. Admission of students is examined and evaluated individually before the semester starts, taking into account the conditions of each student and the degree to which they apply.

1.4. Transition to the Upper Level

Graduates of the First and Emergency Aid program can transfer vertically to Emergency Aid and Disaster Management, Nursing, Nursing and Health Services undergraduate programs with the Vertical Transfer Exam (DGS).

1.5. Graduation Conditions

Students studying in this program must have a GPA of at least 2.00 out of 4.00 in order to graduate, and students must also complete their compulsory internship within the specified time and feature.

1.6. Employment Opportunities

Paramedics who will graduate from the program; They can be employed in 112 emergency, emergency services of hospitals and other health institutions, emergency services of private hospitals, 112 centers and stations and ambulance services.

1.7. Measurement and Evaluation

Each semester, the student is given the right to take 3 exams, namely Midterm, Final Exam and Make-Up Exam. Student's success is evaluated according to the Relative Evaluation System
