

## **1. Opticians Program**

### **1.1. History**

Our “Opticianism” program, which was deemed appropriate to be opened at the meeting of the Council of Higher Education (YÖK) on 22.02.2018, started its academic activities within the body of our Varto Vocational School of Muş Alparslan University.

### **1.2. Degree Earned**

Students who successfully complete this program receive the title of Optician.

### **1.3. Acceptance Conditions**

The Optician Program accepts students according to the Basic Proficiency Test (TYT) score.

### **1.4. Transition to the Upper Level**

If those who successfully complete the associate degree program are successful in the Vertical Transfer Exam (DGS) conducted by ÖSYM; They will be able to transfer to Physics, Optics and Acoustic Engineering, Physics Engineering undergraduate programs.

### **1.5. Graduation Conditions**

Graduation Requirements In order for the student to graduate, he/she must be successful in all the courses given during the 4 semesters and his AGNO must be above 2. In addition, the student must have completed his Professional Internship and been accepted.

### **1.6. Employment Opportunities**

Students graduating from the program with the title of optician can open their own optical shops or work as a responsible manager in optics establishments. In addition, Opticians can also work in businesses that make and sell eyeglasses. Students who will graduate from the program with intensive cooperation with associations and organizations operating in the Optical Sector will gain the title of health technician and will be in the position of authorized personnel to open an optical institution. In addition, students will have the opportunity to apply their knowledge gained in our school during the 'On-Site Training Periods' in the optical sector and get to know the sector closely. For this reason, when students graduate, they will be able to keep up with the rapid developments in the optics sector and find a job easily.

### **1.7. Measurement and Evaluation**

Each semester, the student is given the right to take 3 exams, namely Midterm, Final Exam and Make-Up Exam. The success of the student is evaluated according to the Relative Evaluation System.
